

Poker Hand Rankings

What beats what?


#1 Royal Flush

The highest of all Poker hands, a Royal Flush is 10, J, Q, K, A of the **same** suit.




#2 Straight Flush

A Straight Flush is five cards in consecutive numerical order, all of the **same** suit.




#3 Four of a Kind

Four cards of the same value and any other card.




#4 Full House

Three cards of the same value and another two cards that form a pair.




#5 Flush

Five non-consecutive cards of the **same** suit, named after the highest card, e.g. Jack Flush (pictured).



#6 Straight

Five consecutive cards, but **not** all of the same suit.




#7 Three of a Kind

Three cards of the same value, and two supporting cards that are **not** a pair.



#8 Two Pair

Two sets of pairs, and another random supporting card.



#9 Pair

Two cards of the same value and three random supporting cards.



#10 High Card

A hand with none of the above rankings, named after the highest card e.g. King High (pictured).
